## History of the estate

Produced in the Premières Côtes de Bordeaux appellation and sold under the Bordeaux appellation, the plots of Château La Maroutine are situated on the slopes of the Saint Germain de Graves village in the South part of the Entre Deux Mers Appellation. A family estate since 1789 and bought in 1942 by Jean Darriet, a 6th generation winemaker, Château La Maroutine has been gradually restructured. Now the 8th generation is beginning to leave their imprint. New packaging for this elegant Bordeaux coincides with the renaissance of Château La Maroutine.

## Vinification

A skin contact maceration under nitrogen is done for 12-18 hours to extract the maximum aromas from the skins. Pressing on our pneumatic press, under nitrogen. The alcoholic fermentation starts naturally after one to two days. Alcoholic fermentation in tanks under temperature control (18°C).

## Ageing

Four months on the lees in tanks. Then bottling under strict regulations.

## Blending

80% Sauvignon blanc

20% Sémillon

## Tasting note

Yellow greenish hints. Intense nose of white fruits – grapefruit – and white flowers notes on jasmin, linden and honeysuckle. The palate is rich and intense with same olfactive notes. Long length on the palate with an intense finish driven by a perfect balance of acidity and fruitiness.
