Moshin Vineyards & Winery began in 1989 as the dream of Rick Moshin, a San Jose State University math instructor, and with the Moshin Family's purchase of a ten-acre Pinot Noir vineyard located in the ideal growing climate of the Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, California. Plans for a true gravityflow winery soon came to fruition and in 2005 construction was completed on the winery that you see today. With the future in mind, the following sustainability practices were soon implemented: solar power, in-house nitrogen production, high efficiency steam cleaning and lees collection.





Sensational wine begins in the vineyard. Rick brings with him 30 years of winemaking and over 20 years of winegrowing experience. The Moshin winemaking team shares a vision of capturing the individual expression of each vineyard and vintage in every bottle. Farming practices are sustainable - reflecting the winegrower's connection with the land. Old and New World Pinot Noir clones have been carefully selected for our vineyards - some of which reside on "gold ridge" soil - and iron-rich sandy loam that has been influential in growing the most prized Pinot Noir in Sonoma County.

Our goal at Moshin Vineyards is to carefully guide the grapes through the winemaking process to bring you a wine that expresses an unadulterated view into the heart of the vine. Pinot Noir is our specialty and the unique feature of our winery that greatly supports the goal of making distinctive wine is the use of gravity. Four tiers have been built into the slope of the land to allow the wine to move from crush, to press, to bar-



rel, then to bottle. This gently method helps reserve the delicate and subtle aromas and flavors of Pinot Noir.

We specialize in small lot, hand-crafted wines - focusing mainly on Pinot Noir. We also produce Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Merlot, Petite Sirah, Zinfandel and unique dessert wines. Wine Club members enjoy our most exclusive lots, making membership a fun and special way to experience the artistry and dedication of our winemaking team.
