History of the estate

The vineyard of Château Castera has been known since the 14th century and is one of the oldest vineyards in the Medoc. Other famous historical names bear witness for Castera: Thomas de Montaigne, the brother of the philosopher, and Messire La Boetie, were two prestigious owners of the property. There is still a donjon from that period: it dominates the village of Saint Germain d'Esteuil. In the 17th century, a splendid chapel was built on the property and gave its name to this wine in the 1990s.

Vinification

Moderate extraction produces smooth tannins, which, when combined with relatively short maceration, result in an incredibly fruity wine.

Ageing

Aged for 6 months in oak barrels. This gentle approach to ageing helps obtain subtle, elegant oaky nuances that highlight the intrinsic fruitiness of the grapes.

Blending

60% Cabernet-sauvignon 40% Merlot
