## History of the estate

The Château Bréhat Côtes de Castillon vineyard lies adjacent, for a great part, to the Château Haut-Rocher Saint-Emilion grand cru area and has been in the de Monteil famiyl's property since the 15th century.

#### Vinification

Vinification on land parcels, manual crop sorting, temperature control, long vatting.

### **Ageing**

50% in covered vats and 50% in French oak barrels ( new and one wine ). Blend at the end of aging.

### **Blending**

15% Cabernet-sauvignon

15% Cabernet franc

70% Merlot

## **Tasting note**

The 2016 Bréhat has a lifted red cherry, cranberry and violet bouquet that develops more earthy characteristics with time in the glass. The medium-bodied palate offers fine tannin, nice focus and an appealing combination of intensity and elegance on the finish. Check out this great Côtes de Castillon.
