History of the estate

The Château Bréhat Côtes de Castillon vineyard lies adjacent, for a great part, to the Château Haut-Rocher Saint-Emilion grand cru area and has been in the de Monteil family's property since the 15th century.

Vinification

Vinification on land parcels, manual crop sorting, temperature control, long vatting.

Ageing

50% in covered vats and 50% in French oak barrels (new and one wine). Blend at the end of aging.

Blending

15% Cabernet-sauvignon

15% Cabernet franc

70% Merlot

Tasting note

The 2016 Bréhat has a lifted red cherry, cranberry and violet bouquet that develops more earthy characteristics with time in the glass. The medium-bodied palate offers fine tannin, nice focus and an appealing combination of intensity and elegance on the finish. Check out this great Côtes de Castillon.
