Area

9 ha

History of the estate

The creation of this vineyard dates back to the 19th century. Since then, the vineyard has been owned by the same family. It is located on the east slopes of Saint Emilion, thus offering a perfect location. This clay soil gives fruity and expressive wines, with a beautiful texture in the mouth.

Vinification

Traditional winemaking in concrete vats with temperature control. Vatting during 21 days minimum. Aerated pumping over, load shedding, vatting for 3 weeks.

Ageing

12 months with 1/3 of vats and 2/3 in oak barrels (2/3), of which 20% are new 20% of 1 wine and 60% of barrels two years old and older.

Blending

70% Merlot

15% Cabernet franc

9% Cabernet-sauvignon

6% Malbec

Tasting note

Beautiful red deep color. The nose shows fine notes of red fruits. The wine offers delicate oak aromas that are powerful and well-engrained. On the palate, the wine is elegant thanks to silky yet racy tannins. The wine has a long finish with a nice balance between the toasty oak and fruit notes.
