About this wine

The great accomplishment. Château La Fleur de Boüard represents the brilliant harvest that resulted from the seed planted by the de Boüard family in this vineyard in 1998. Benefitting from the inventive know-how of Hubert, Coralie and Matthieu de Boüard, supported by their technical director Philippe Nunes, Château La Fleur de Boüard has flourished and become the flagship of the Lalandede- Pomerol appellation. Blended with 80% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon, the fruit from each individual plot is vinified separately using gravity alone in small truncated cone-shaped tanks. The wine is then aged in oak for 18 to 24 months in barrels, of which 75% are new.

Vinification

Preferment maceration at 8-10°C. Alcoholic fermentation. Maceration of 3 to 5 weeks. Vinification in French oak barrels. Malo lactic fermentation in barrels.

Ageing

18 to 24 months. 75% to 80% new barrels.

Blending

12% Cabernet franc3% Cabernet-sauvignon85% Merlot
